"This morning I went on the Tucson Citizen's website to read the Mexican Flu stories. And I was appalled by some of the comments made by editors, public officials and bloggers alike," Garza said.

"Sidestep hysteria and xenophobia,' the Tucson Citizen Editor advised. 'Border Controls do not work. Travel restrictions do not work,' Gregory Hartl World Health Organization spokesperson said. 'Viruses don't recognize borders,' wrote Sierra.

"Well, if quarantines and restrictions in movement don't work, don't slow the advance of the disease, then Why have Mexican officials closed all public events in Mexico City, Why have Cuban officials banned all flights coming in from and going to Mexico, and Why are American officials closing schools," Garza asked.
